1. Admission to the University.
2. Completion of OTA Core Curriculum and minimum GPA of 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale).
3. Submission of materials in admissions packet by January 20th of year planning to be admitted to the fall class.
4. Interview with Occupational Therapists Admission Committee.
5. A combined score that includes the standardized interview with the Occupational Therapists Admission Committee, cumulative GPA, and submission of all required documents. Thirty students with the highest scores will be admitted to the OTA Program.
