

### Program Description

This workshop is an advanced learning opportunity for faith community nurses who have completed the Basic Parish/Faith Community Nurse Preparation Curriculum. The content is designed to provide on-going educational support for practicing faith community nurses.

Common myths of mental health conditions are explored. Selected mental health conditions and sign and symptoms are reviewed. Appropriate interventions for the parish nurse are examined.

A variety of leadership styles and theories will be discussed. Application of theories that apply to leadership will be the emphasis. Servant Leadership is included as a model for ministry.

### Program Objectives

At the end of this conference participants will be able to:

1. Discuss mental health wellness.
2. Identify common experiences of families living with a person who is mentally ill.
3. Describe common mental health conditions.
4. Explore mental wellness interventions.
5. Discuss selected theories that apply to leadership styles.
6. Discuss leadership styles.
7. Identify characteristics of an effective leader.
8. Discuss the concept of servant leadership applied to parish nurse ministry.

Parish nurses, nurses in faith communities, and lay persons interested in fostering the role of the faith based nurse.
